KANSAS CITY ASSOC. EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTORS –

DEADLINE- MARCH 15, 2010

The Kansas City Associated Equipment Distributors awards four annual scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each (\$500 per semester) to four full-time students. This is a \$500 scholarship available to graduating seniors. This scholarship is a single scholarship funded by the St. John's Hospital-Aurora Auxiliary. Special consideration will be given to students who plan to pursue a career in the accounting and/or health field.

JEAN ANN CARR SCHOLARSHIP – DEADLINE – MARCH 31, 2010

Special consideration will be given to students who plan to pursue a career in the education field.

CU SUCCEED SCHOLARSHIP- MARCH 31, 2010

AURORA BOOSTER CLUB ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP –

DEADLINE–APRIL 1, 2010

\$500 goes to one senior boy and one senior girl who has participated in athletics all four years of high school.

MISSOURI BAPTIST HERITAGE – DEADLINE – APRIL 1, 2010

A maximum of four scholarships will be awarded to Missouri Baptist high school seniors or college freshmen interested in attending Hannibal Lagrange college or Southwest Baptist University. These scholarships are awarded to the students that best complete the spirit and letter of this scholarship application.

MAXINE ARMSTRONG SCHOLARSHIP – DEADLINE – APRIL 2, 2010

This scholarship is intended to provide financial support to Aurora High School graduates who have an economic need to continue their education at vocational technical school, a two year college or a four year college/university.

TOM WARD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – DEADLINE- APRIL 9, 2010

Applicants for this award must be graduating seniors planning to attend college on a full-time basis during the 2010-2011 school year. Scholarship is for \$1200.

DEADLINE-APRIL 15, 2010**

This is an eight day program where participants will organize their own city, county and state governments. They will also campaign for office and hold court systems, publish a daily newspaper and create daily radio and television broadcast.

ROBERT C. BYRD-MO DEPT. OF ELEM. & SEC. EDUCATION-

DEADLINE –APRIL 15, 2010

The Robert C. Byrd Honors Scholarship Program is a federally-funded scholarship for students who show outstanding academic achievement and promise. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, in cooperation with the United States Department of Education, provides outstanding scholars with awards up to \$1500 per year for their first four years of study at four-year institution of higher education. Renewal is based upon maintenance of good standing as defined by the institution of higher education.

CHARLES L. BACON-DEADLINE-APRIL 20, 2010

Two awards of \$500 are given annually in memory of the first Missourian to serve as National Commander of The American Legion. Eligible are individuals who are currently members of The American Legion, the American Legion Auxiliary, or the Sons of The American Legion, or a descendant* of a member of any thereof. Applicants must be unmarried and under the age of 21, and must use the scholarship as a full-time student in a accredited college or university and a resident of Missouri.

ERMAN W. TAYLOR-DEADLINE-APRIL 20, 2010

Two \$500 awards are given annually to a student planning on obtaining a degree in education, in honor of this Past National Executive Committeeman from Missouri. To be eligible, individuals must: (1) be a descendant* of a veteran who served 90 or more days of active duty in the armed forces and having an honorable discharge; (2) be a Missouri resident; (3) use the award as a full-time student at an accredited college or university; (4) provide a copy of the discharge certificate for the veteran on whose the application is made; and (6) submit an essay of 500 words or less on the subject **In your opinion, what was the most significant world event of 2007/2008?**

JOSEPH J. FRANK-DEADLINE-APRIL 20, 2010

Five awards of \$500 are given annually to individuals who are descendants of a veteran. Applicants must have attended a full session of The American Legion Boys State or The American legion Auxiliary

Girls State program. Applicants must be unmarried, under the age of 21, a current resident of the state of Missouri and must use the scholarship as a full time student in a accredited college or university.
